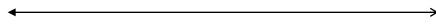

- **County Champions & Rate of Gain Champions** - If your child has a Hereford steer, heifer or feeder calf that is County Champion Over All Breeds at your County Fair this summer, he or she is entitled to a \$100 award from the SDHA. If your child has a Hereford that is the Over All County Rate of Gain Champion, he or she is entitled to a \$100 award from the SDHA.
